

### Deck the Halls Challenge!

The song “Deck the Halls” uses six notes from the C major scale. Here is the song:



Notice that the circled notes are a half step lower than C!

Can you **transpose** “Deck the Halls” to a different major scale? Remember, to build the first five notes of the major scale, follow this pattern:

1<sup>st</sup> note – W – W – H – W

Then, stretch down a half step to play the circled notes.

How many scales can you use to play “Deck the Halls”? Put a check next to each you can do!
