## Note Match! Instructions

1. Print out each of the three sheets on paper or card stock.
2. Cut along the lines to create your cards. You should have 3 decks of 14 cards each.
3. To play, put the three card decks face down in the following order: clefs, numbers, letters.
4. Have a student draw a card from each deck and place it on the piano rack. Once the last card is placed, they must quickly find the given note and play it with the correct hand and finger.
5. As a bonus, ask students to name and play all five notes they have under their fingers.
