



Transposing Challenge # 4:

“Deck the Halls”

The traditional song “Deck the Halls” uses six notes from the major scale.

Notice that the circled notes are a half step below the first note of the scale!

Can you **transpose** “Deck the Halls” to a different major scale? Remember, to build the first five notes of the major scale, follow this pattern:

1st note – Whole step – Whole step – Half step – Whole step

Then, stretch down a half step to play the circled notes.

Put a check mark next to each scale you can use to play “Deck the Halls!”
