


Transposing Challenge # 6:

"For He's a Jolly Good Fellow"

The traditional song "For He's a Jolly Good Fellow" uses the first six notes of the major scale and the primary chords: I, IV, and V7. Can you spot these in the music below?





Can you **transpose** "For He's a Jolly Good Fellow" into the following keys? (Watch out for the skip in the melody in measure 6.) Put a check mark next to each key you can do! (Hint: remember to build your scale and chords first!)
